By his Lordps Lieuten^t of Maryland.

Whereas Robert Smith Thomas Yewell and Thomas Lewis being Inhabitants of this province have Secretly fled fled out of the Province, and adjoynd themselves to persons hostilely affected against this Province, and doe hence return into the Province by night as enemies and Robbers, and kill and Carry away the Cattle of the Inhabitants, These are to Summon the Said Robert Smith Thomas Yewell and Thomas Lewis to render themselves to the Sherriff of S^t Maries County or at S^t Inigo's ffort afore the 4th ffebruary next upon perill to be proclaimed Rebels and Robbers and as Such to be proceeded ag^t both themselves and all persons and Communities (yea throughout of the Province) that Shall harbour them or any Of them after notice hereof.

Jan 19 You are to Search at S^t Inigo's house for all goods belonging to other then the present Inhabitants within the house and to take into your possession, all goods there found upon M^r Copleys Land, but what the Said present possessors of them Shall averr by Oath to have been their own proper goods and not to have belonged to any of the Inhabitants on the 14 ffebr 1644 or Since, And Such as Shall make claim to any Such goods by Gift Sale, depositions trust or Otherwise, you are to warn to be at the Court on 4th ffebr next, to Shew Cause why Such goods Should not be restored to the owners, And return an Inventory of all goods as Shall be taken into your Custody by vertue hereof And this Shall be your warrant.
