Then was taken into Consideracōn the p^rseruacōn of the prouince ag^t the incursion of the Cinego Indians who lately killed some English in Ann Arundell County & alsoe entred the County of S^t Marys Ordred th^t Warr be pclaimed ag^t the Cinego Jndians th^t a Reward of a hundred Armes lenght of Roan Oake be giuen to eu^y pson whether Indian or English th^t shall bring in a Cinego prison^r or both his Eares if he be slayne That all the Kings of the freind Jndians be sent to, to arme out their people in pursuit of the Cinego Jndians & th^t the respespectiue Millitary Officers within the seu^rall diuisions of this puince doe arme out such & soe many of their seu^rall Companys as they shall thinke fitt to goe in Company wth the freind Jndians to pursue the Enemy, & that they presse such horses armes & ammuicōn as from tyme to tyme they shall find Necessary & th^t they keepe a p^ticular Acco^t of the s^d armes & Amncōn soe by them pressed to be sent downe in Convenient tyme to y^r Gou^rno^r & Councell.

p. 206 That every Officer millitary doe from time to time send all intelligence to the Majo^r Lieu^t Coll or Coll of the Respectiue Regim^{ts} & th^t the s^d Majo^r Lieu^t Coll or Coll doe from tyme to tyme send Jntelligence to the Gouerno^r & Cou^ccell & th^t they keepe a Correspondence one with another And whereas there is a Cinego Indian taken prisoner in Patapsco Riuer who alledges he came to seeke a peace & brought a present intended to us & the Sasq^ehanough Indians Ordred th^t the said Jndian be sent for downe to S^t Marys & kep^t in Irons & th^t a Lre be written to gen^rall Stuy^uzent to request him to giue notice to the Cinegoes trading at fort range th^t wee haue such a pson prison^r whom wee shall keepe aliue till wee see whether they desire a peace really or not because noe present come & th^t if they desire not a peace as hee alleadges th^t wee shall put him to death & th^t Jacob Clauson doe giue notice to the Sasq^esahanough Jndians of this our Jntencōn & to require them to declare whether they are willing to Joyne with us in this Messuage till which answer Come this Lre shall be deferred.
