for that noe occassion relateing to the state or welfare of this
province at present offers That requires the sitting of the said
Generall Assembly Upon the said second Tuesday in Aprill
next Wee the said Deputy Govern^{ers} with the Advice of his
Lordsp^s Council have thought fit to prorogue and the said
Assembly is hereby prorogued accordingly untill the Laste
Tuesday in October next next ensueing the date of these pres-
ents And the severall and respective sheriffs of this province are
hereby strictly charged and comanded to make publike pro-
clamacōn hereof in the most publike places of their Counties
And give notice to the Dep^{tie} and Delegates of the severall
and respective Counties That all excuses set apart they and p. 204
every of them be and personally appeare at the city of St
Maries Upon the said Last Tuesday in October next then and
there to doe and consent to such things which shall by the
favour of God happen there to be ordained and enacted
Given etc the 19th of March 1688.
