A Petition of the Inhabitants scituate vpon the south side of Potapsco River and others holding land there, desiring to bee restored into the County of Ann Arundell from whence at first they were tak into Baltemo^r County by reason of their greate distance from and in commodious wayes of goeing to the County Court of Baltemo^r &c^a read and rejected, This house Considering that Baltemo^r County being already very small and for other motives the same remaine as now it is.
