Then mett together on purpose to treat with the Empero^r and great men of Pascattoway according to the result of the Councell at their last meeteing, notice being given to the said Indians to meete his L^{spp} and his Councell here this Day in ord^r thereunto, Who being not yett come his L^{spp} p^rceeds to advise with his Councell touching the conference.

It was proposed by his L^{spp}: whither or noe they should proceed to Any further resolution touching the said Conference with the Pascattoway Indians then what was concluded on the last Councell Day before such time as they had spoken with the Empero^r and his great men, Which was voted in the negative and that what was then concluded on to be delivered to the said Indians was sufficient untill such time as his L^{spp} should first have had some conference with them and heard what they have to say and p^rpose to his L^{spp}:

It was likewise p^rposed that if the Empero^r and his great men should upon their addresses to his L^{spp} acquaint him that his Governo^r and Councell (in his L^{spps}: Absence) had accused them of breaking their Articles with us by laying the murd^r
