Maryland ss: A Proclamation.

Proclamation signifying the constitution of the Governmt in his Ex^{ncies} absence Whereas by a former Proclamation beareing Date the 25th day of September last past amongst other things therein contained it was made & knowne and published that the Comand & Charge of this their Ma^{ts} Province was by the death of the late Governo^r Copley and absence of Cap^t ffancis Nicholson comitted vnto me, with full power & Authority
