

The Same Ord^s and Instructions sent to Cap^t Brightwell Lib. H. D. Comander of the Party of Rangers upon Potomock. Whitehall

July the 6th 1696.

Came Cap^t John Oldton and in Answer to the Deposition p. 366 of Thomas Roberts says that the Information therein Contain'd is false, as he Can prove by the whole Company and that he had Offered the Leiveten^s place to him once who Rejected it;

Whereupon he put in another; And lastly he does say that the s^d Roberts is altogether unquallified for the s^d Office; He is Ordered to make answer in writing what way the s^d Roberts is unqualified, and why he was not put in his Leivten^t pursuant to Ord^r.

Order for prosecuting Severall Members of Assembly and Justices &c^a Ordered that M^r Attorney and Sollicito^r Gen^{ll} doe imediately (after the Assembly is dissolved) prosecute the Severall Members that have taken Tob^o of the people contrary to Law and the Justices of the County Courts for allowing thereof and that they prepare what process they think most agreeable to Law ag^t that time.

Ordr for prosecuting Mr Kenelm Cheseldyn and Coll John Cood &c^a Ordered likewise th^t Due prosecution be made ag^t M^r Kenelm Cheseldyn and Coll John Cood, about the money by them taken (in the time of the Revolution) without the Kings Ord^r and that they insist upon good Bayle.
