An Act Ascerteining what Damages shall be Allowed upon protested Bills of Exch:

Court within this Province any Law Statute or usage to the

Contrary Notwithstanding.

Be it Enacted by the Kings most Excellent Maty by and with the advice and Consent of this Present Generall Assembly and the Authority of the same That there shall not be Allowed to any person or persons whatsoever having Iust Cause to Implead any person or persons whatsoever liveing or resideing within the Province in any Court wthin this Province upon any Bill of Exchange drawn for any sume or sums of money whatsoever payable in England or elsewhere and brought in here protested more then the sume of Twenty pounds p Cent Damages over and above the Debt sued for
