Henry Earle of Romney and John Glover Gent.
bearing date the 21th of March 1695. whereby
is Signified their being fully Authorized &
Empow^r'd to Call to Acco^t and Receive from all
Com^{manders} Officers and other persons whatsoever
any ways Concern'd in and ab^t the taking Con-
demning of any Prize Ships Goods &^{ca} of what

Nature Soever (brought for Condemnation into these Ameri-
can parts Portugall and Italy) his Ma^{ty} full part and propotion
of the Same. A Letter of Attorney under the hands and
Seals of the s^d Earle of Romney and M^r Glover being thereto
Annexed both attested under the Seal of Mayorality of the City p. 502
of London and a Notary Publicks hand & Seal Impowering
the s^d M^r Robinson fully to Act and doe in the p^rmisses within
his Ma^{ty} Province of Maryland and the parts Adjacent accord-
ing to the Utmost Extent of the s^d Commission.

Produced also a Commission to the s^d M^r Rob-
inson and others under the Seal of his Ma^{ty} high
Court of Admiralty in England Dated the 17th day
of September Anno 1696: for putting the Com-
mission of the s^d Earle of Romney &^{ca} in due
Execution within this Province w^{ch} were all
Ordered to be Recorded in the hon^{ble} the Secry^{rs}

Office or Councill Book (which he thought most fit) Com-
manding all persons Concern'd to Yield due Obedience and
Conform themselves thereto accordingly and that a Just Acco^t
be given of what Prizes have been here tryed and Con-
demned and what his Ma^{ty} part of the Same is, which Acco^t
is to be Given by his Ma^{ty} Receiver and a Copy of the Pro-
ceedings by the Register of his Ma^{ty} Court of Vice Adm^{lty}
here within this Province upon the s^d M^r Robinsons application
for the Same.
