His Ex^{ncy} is pleas'd to say that what part of the two foremention'd prizes, belongs to him as Vice Admirall, he bestowes the Same upon the Comanders of the Ships that took them

for their further Encouragemt

Produced by the s^d M^r Jenings two Comissions unto him Granted from under the Seal of the Admiralty in England, the one bearing date the 7th of Decemb^r 1696. and the other the 23^d of the s^d Instant Decemb^r with Interrogatories Annext, Empowering him to put in fforce his other Commission.

Ordered that the same be Recorded and all Obedience Given thereto accordingly His Ex^{ncy} being pleased to tell the s^d M^r Jenings that if he could Inform him any thing that might be Serviceable to his Ma^{ty} about the Execution of those Comissions Some Ord^r should be given therein.
