The Bill Proposed to Encourage Importing Coine into this Province having been read att this Board it is remarked thereupon that att present as the Law for Religion viz^t the 40 p poll stands, this Law seems to reencounter therewith will be in great Measure infringed if not Occasioned to be wholly Abrogated thereby

It is further remarked the Justices of the Countys thereby having such power given them to declare and Ascertain att what rate money shall pay Tobbacco it will Occasion great Confusion and Clamour in that it is Impossible all the Justices of the County Courts should Agree in Opinion as to the Just Value of Tobbacco or that the Tobbacco in every County should be of like Esteem
