A Bill for laying an imposicon of 3^d p^h upon Tob^o &c. Read the first time and ordered to be read againe to morrow morning.

Voted whether this act shall endure for two or three yeares. Carried by majority of votes that the same continue 3 yeares and to the end of the next Sessions of Assembly which shall happen after the end of the said 3 yeares

A Bill for preventing the abuses of horse Stealers &c. Read and referred to the Consideracōn of the next Sessions of Assembly.

An Act for naturallizacōn of Severall p^{sons} &c. Read and assented to by the house.

An Act investing Land in Dorothy Stevens.

An Act investing Land in S^t James parrish. All three engrossed and assented to by the house of Dellegates.

And Ordered that Maj^r W^m Dent and M^r Phill^o Loyd carry the same to his Ex^{cy} and Councill. They returne and say they have delivered them.

James ffrisby and Francis Ienkins Esq^{rs} from the hon^{ble} Councill enter the house and deliver the Speaker some Treatys made with the Indians, which was ordered to be read to morrow morning.
