thousand pounds of tobb^o due from the Estate of M^r Sam^l
Withers and fowerteen Thousand pounds of tobb^o from the
Estate of M^r John Llewelin decd whose Ex^r and Adm^r pre-
tend not to have any Assetts to pay yo^r pet^{rs} Just demands.

Wherefore yo^r Petitioners being sensible that the sd M^r
John Llewelin and M^r Samuell Withers did leave a good
Sufficient Estate in Lands by the Sale whereof yo^r Pet^r and
all other their Just Creditors may be Satisfied they Therefore
