Forasmuch as it hath been represented to this present General Assembly tha<sup>t</sup> by the Ill Situacon of the Parish Church in Cecill County being built on the South side of Elk River within the said County the Inhabitants on the north side of Elk  
p. 239 River Cannot come to that Church & are thereby Deprived of the Great Blessing of having the Gospell preached among them for remedy whereof It is prayed That it may be Enacted;

And be it Enacted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majestys Governour Councill and Assembly of this Province and the Authority of the same That from and after the first day of May One thousand Seven hundred and Six all that part of Cecill County lying on the North side of Elk River being Bounded
