An Act for Vesting and Settling Certain Lands In John Whittington and his Heires Late the Estate and Inheritance of a Certain Daniell Toaes for and towards Sattisfication and payment of a debt Due from the said Toaes and paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Whittington. p. 240

Whereas John Whittington of Kent County Gent: by his petition to this Present Generall Assembly hath sett forth that a Certain Daniell Toaes late of the said County Deceased being in his Life time Indebted to a certaine Richard Swetnam Late of Talbott County Deceased in the sume of thirty five Thousand pounds of Tobacco & being Willing & Desirous to have the same Satisfied and payed by his last will and Testament in writing did leave severall tracts of Land to be sold for the payment of his Debts and of his said will did Constitute and appoint his son Daniell Toaes the son & Executor suffered himself to be sued for the said Debt Due to the said Swetnam and being taken in Execution for the same did prevail w<sup>th</sup> the said John Whittington and a Certain Michaell Miller since Deceased to become security for payment of the said Debt &
