We cannot see what Reasons you have to reject the Allowances usually made the Members of this Board for their Attendance and Assistance in the High Court of Chancery and recommend it to your Consideration that the wonted Allowances be made them

The Honble President advanced ten Dollars to M^r Brooke the Messenger sent from Virginia by Governor Spotswoods Express with the publick Packets and her Majesty's Proclamation for the Cessation of Arms agreed with France which Money we desire may be repaid his Honour out of the Treasury
