And then his Excy was pleased to declare that with the Advice of the right honorable the Lord Prop<sup>rys</sup> Council of State within this Province he thought fit to Prorogue this present Generall Assembly till the Seventh day of October next to which time the Same was accordingly Prorogued.

Afterwards M<sup>r</sup> Speaker with the rest of the members of this House return'd to their own House And then M<sup>r</sup> Speaker resumed the Chair and reported to the House that his Excy the Governour with the Advice of the right honorable the Lord prop<sup>ry</sup>'s Council of State in this Province had prorogued this present Gen<sup>l</sup> [Assembly] to the Seventh day of October next to which Time this House Accordingly prorogues itself. p. 117

So Endeth this third Sessions of Assembly held for this Province after his most gracious Majesty was pleased to restore the right honorable the Lord Prop<sup>ry</sup> to the Government of this Province this tenth day of May Anno D<sup>mi</sup> 1718.
