Ordered that Commission be made out According to Act of p. 35 Assembly & Directed to Phil Lloyd Esq<sup>r</sup> Col<sup>o</sup> Rich<sup>d</sup> Tilghman & Col Ward to Decide the Differences of Consequence that shall Happen Between the English & Indians on the Eastern Shoar whether it be about the Bounds of their Land or Otherwise as the Case shall Require
