We have considered your Message with the Bill for relief of John Beale & conceive the clause to enable him to maintain An Action for his Damages is only to remove some Doubts that have been occasioned meerly by his Oppressive and Injurious treatment and that should he Suffer in this part meerly thro his want of Ability to Maintain his right when first disputed, it would be so farr giving his opponants advantage of their Own Wrong as seems not agreeable to the Justice of the Legislature nor the equity of this Cause. We therefore Unanimously desire your Honours for Justice Sake to Concur wth us in the passing the bill as proposed.
