By the Committee of Agrievances and Courts of Justice pursuant to the Order of the Lower House for Inspecting the Publick Records April 17, 1735

Your Committee having Inspected the Records in the Commissarys Office, And also the Report of the Committee of boath Houses of Assembly made on the Thirteenth Day of June 1730 in Relation to the Inventories Missing in the said Office and not Recorded.
