And out of the Goods, Debts, & Chattles of the s^d Deceased w^{ch} haue, may, or shall come to yo^e hands or possesⁿ well & truly to pay the Debts due by the s^d Deceased, soe far forth, as the same shall therto extend, & the Law will charge you, according to the true ualew & summe thereof. You hauing first taken yo^r Oath well & truly to adm̄ister the same. And to make or cause to bee made a True & perfect Inuentory of All & singular the goods Chattles & Debts of the s^d deceased, w^{ch} haue, may or shall come to yo^r hands, possesⁿ or knowledge & allsoe a true & iust Acc^t, in & concerning yo^r Adm̄istration therein.
