We request you to have the Shorts and Bran sold to the best Advantage you can, for the State, unless there is a Continental Quartermaster at Frederick who will give a Receipt for them, and think you have acted very properly in not separating the Midlings from the fine Flour, in this Manner we wish you to have the whole of the Wheat manufactured.
