That the said Treasurer pay to John Shaw eleven hundred and seventy Pounds for cleaning the Public Arms and seventy nine Pounds, ten shillings and three pence of the new Emission in lieu three thousand one hundred and seventy six Pounds, ten shillings due him p Acc<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud. G<sup>l</sup>
