We have requested Col<sup>o</sup> Forrest to send up such of the Soldiers of the Extra Regiment, rejected by the Board of War, as are able to march at this Time. The Pay of the Soldiers in Cap<sup>t</sup> Reid's Company, is the same with those in the Line. M<sup>r</sup> Jacobs likewise has an Order for the Cloathing desired.

[Council to Andrew Buchanan Esqr. Lieut of Balt County]

Sir The Enclosure is a Copy of Governor Jefferson's Letter, received this Day by Express. We are not inclined to believe the Possession of Baltimore Town is an Object with the British Army now in Virginia, yet, as the Fleet and Army still remain in that State and its Neighbourhood, and their future Designs not clearly indicated by their past Conduct, we wish, in this State of uncertainty and Doubt, that you may not be wholly unprepared for their Reception, nor, on the other Hand, put the State to Expense in Preparations to frustrate their supposed Intentions. Your Orders to the Militia in Baltimore Town and its Vicinity, to hold themselves in Readiness, at a short Notice, we think the most eligible Measure under present Circumstances.
