Stoddert of the 5th and General Smallwood each, a suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts for the year 1781. and also to Major John Steward a suit of Cloaths and Linen for two shirts for the year 1781. and Aquila Deaver, Jesse Grace, Paul Richards and Thomas Bailey of the 3^d Lawrence Hurdle, William Lynch of the 7th and William Roberts, Benjamin Gray and John Milstead of the 1st Regiment, each, a suit of Cloaths, one hat and one Blanket.

The western shore Treasurer pay to John King thirty six pounds, twelve shillings and six pence of the new Emission in lieu of one thousand four hundred and sixty five pounds due him per Acc^t passed by the Dep^y Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to John Bullen three hundred and ninety pounds of the same Emission on Acc^t

That the Issuing Commissary deliver to Capt Rob^t Berry seven Days provisions for five men to Act as look out.
