Every Vessel adequate to the Service intended, which have been impressed, we require you to take immediately to the Head of Elk, to which Place they are to proceed with all possible Dispatch when they arrive there they are to be under the Directions of the Deputy Quarter Master General for this State.

[Council to Capt. John Pitt.]

You are to proceed down the Bay with all possible Dispatch as far as Hampton Road, if you can without great Hazard, and when you arrive there you are to make very particular Inquiry respecting the French Fleet, whether they are in the Bay and if in the Bay where sationed, if not in the Bay whether they are cruising off the Capes and of what Number they consist; how many Ships of the Line; how many Frigates and how many Transports and in what Manner they are supplied with Provisions; as soon as you obtain full and precise Information you are to return and make your Report to this Board. If you fall in with Capt. William Middleton you must desire him to return and communicate what Intelligence he has been able to collect.
