John Courts Jones, Capt David Lynn of the 4th Regim^t and Lieut Clement Skerret of the Artillery each, Linen for two Shirts due for the present year and also to Capt John Mitchell of the 4th Regim^t Cloth and Trimmings for a waist coat and Breeches and Linen for four shirts due him for the present year.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Benjamin Price fifteen pounds of the Bills emitted under the " Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds &^{ca} " of the money appropriated for the Officers going to the Southward.
