That the said Treasurer pay to Joshua Dorsey twenty one pounds two shillings and three pence of the same Emission of the money appropriated for the Defence of the State allowed him by this Board for Acting as an Assistant Clerk from the 7th September to this Day inclusive.

That M^r Shaw deliver to M^r Quynn Steel Sufficient for eighteen axes making for the public

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Maj^r Brookes, red Cloth for facing to a Regimental Coat.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Samuel Thomas Seventy five pounds Specie to be delivered over to the special Council.
