Under the Act of November Session 1779 for the immediate Supply of Flour, and other Provision for the Army, the Commissioners appointed by the Law, seized in the Hands of M^r Conrad Theodore Wederstrandt, a large Quantity of Wheat. M^r Wederstrandt at that Time, was a Continental Commissary, and we have Reason to believe the Wheat seized in his Hands, was purchased by him as Commissary for the United States.
