That the said Treasurer pay to Christian Orendorff thirty Pounds agreeable to a Resolution of this Board of the 22^d July 1781—Sixty Pounds in lieu of two suits of Cloaths and eight shirts for the last and present years and twenty five Pounds, fourteen shillings of the same Emission for Stores to the first instant on Account.

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Thompson nineteen Pounds five shillings & two pence of the same Emission due on a Certificate issued agreeable to the Act to adjust the Debts due from this State.

Permission granted to Peter Ubric of Frederick County to solicit leave from His Excellency General Washington or the Commanding Officer at the Out Posts of the American Army for Licence to go into the City of New York for the Purpose of obtaining a Passage from thence to Germany to settle among his Friends.

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Capt Daniel Brian forty Pounds of the Bills emitted under the Act for the Emission of Bills of Credit &^{ca} on Account.
