Humbly Sheweth that att a Prouin<sup>all</sup> Court held the 9<sup>th</sup> day of ffebruary 1663, Ord<sup>r</sup> past ags<sup>t</sup> the p<sup>ft</sup>: for the s<sup>d</sup> Ackworths not appearing to answey the suite of John Nuthall in an accōn of debt to the uallue of twenty nine pounds and a halfe of Beauror that now the p<sup>ft</sup> hauing heard of the s<sup>d</sup> Ackworth desires writt to arrest the said Ackworth, and that this Honno<sup>ble</sup> Court will be pleased to Order the p<sup>ft</sup>: satisfacōn for his loss and damāges susteyned by the afore-said Ackworth And (as in duty bound) hee shall euer pray &<sup>c</sup>

The said Dobson d<sup>ds</sup> summons for John Niccolls and Mary Clocker Jun<sup>r</sup> to testifye &<sup>c</sup> in Causo ut supra att the said Prouin<sup>all</sup> Court uppon perill of forfeitinge 500<sup>th</sup> each person in Case they appeare not &<sup>c</sup>—

The humble pet<sup>n</sup> of Christopher Dobson Sheweth

That Abraham Wattson did assume upon himselfe the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 1663 to pay yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>r</sup> the sume of ffowre hundred and fifty poundes of tobacco and Caske as by his Obligacon more att large appeares, Now the said Abra<sup>m</sup> Wattson delays paym<sup>t</sup> to the prejudice of yo<sup>r</sup> petition<sup>r</sup> wherefore he humbly Craues Order of this Honno<sup>ble</sup> Court for damāges and Cost of suite And as in duty bound he shall euer pray &<sup>c</sup>—
