

- No. 1 An Act Impowering the Justices of Frederick County Court, to levy
 Liber H. S. on the taxable Inhabitants of the said County, a Sum of Current
 p. 141 Money for the Use therein mentioned.

[Preamble.] Whereas George Gordon, late Sheriff of Frederick County, by his humble Petition to this present General Assembly, has set forth, That when the Petitioner was Sheriff of Frederick County, the Magistrates of said County were of Opinion that the Ordinary License Money belonged to the County, that the Petitioner accounted with the County for One Hundred and Eighteen Pounds, as per Certificate doth appear, being Fines arising on the Breach of the Act of Assembly for regulating Ordinaries, &c. and Ordinary License Money, and the Magistrates of the said County thought they could not levy the aforesaid Sum without an Act of Assembly; therefore, the Petitioner prayed there might be an Act passed, to empower the Magistrates of Frederick County, to levy the aforesaid Sum of One Hundred and Eighteen Pounds, with the Sheriff's Commission, to enable the Petitioner to pay the said Sum to the Commissioners of the Loan Office, and prevent his Bonds being put in Suit: Which being thought reasonable, it is prayed that it may be enacted, And be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Justices of Frederick County, for the Time being, shall, and may, and they are hereby authorized and directed to assess and levy on the taxable Inhabitants of the said County, the aforesaid Sum of One Hundred and Eighteen Pounds Current Money, in Bills of Credit, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five Pounds per Centum for Collection, at the laying of the next County Levy; which said Sum of One Hundred and Eighteen Pounds, shall be collected by the Sheriff of the said County, who is hereby authorized and directed to collect the same, and to pay the said Money, when so collected, to the aforesaid George Gordon, or his Executors or Administrators.
