These are thearefore to declare to all whom it may concerne That the sd power of Judicature soe graunted as afforesayd to the sd Phillip Conier Comaunder and the rest of the Comission^{rs} of Kent ought and shall Continue in force Accordinge to the Act of Assembly notwithstandinge any thinge that hath hapned since by reasson of the late trouble arissinge or any other Cause whatsoever And the sayd Comaunder & Comission^{rs} of the sayd Countye of Kent are heareby Required in the Name of his Highnes the Lord Protecto^r of England to Attend to their duty and trust Comitted to them, to the best of their knowledge & abillity Wheareof the may not to faill uppon their pill giuen the 24th of Septemb^r 1655

The Cou^{rt} doth thearefore Order th^t the sd James Horner shall bee paid out of the Cropp of the forementioned three Swedes twoe barrels of Corne and for his 14 dayes worcke 25th of to^b a day to bee paid upon demaund with Court Charges els execution

m^r Henery Morgan hauinge pettissioned the Court for 10 dayes worcke & diet wrought for Andrew Hanson valerus Leo & Swan Swanson in their Crope, the sayd 10 dayes beeing made apeare to the Cou^{rt} to bee unsatisfied

The Cou^{rt} doth thearefore order that the three Swedes before mentioned shall pay out of the^r Crope to m^r Morgan upon all demaundes for the 10 dayes worcke & diet 25th of to^b a day & Court Charges els execution
