M^{rs} Sarah Ellingsworth sworne in open Courtt

saith that when M^r Williams threw downe M^r Robbins his fence She doth thinke there was Not an Eare of Corne or butt fue Stalkes Standing and further saith not Sarah Ellingsworth

M^r Rob^t Turner Sworne in open Courtt

saith th^e same with M^{rs} Sarah Ellingsworth & further th^t M^r Robbins man Before th^t torned into th^e field his masters horse & further saith Not Rob^t Turner
