

Know all men by these p^rsents, that I Jn^o Erickson of th^e Isle of Kent doth acknowledge for good Causes & Considerations mee theare unto moueing, and haue Re^c full satisfaction for th^e same, doth acknowledge to haue sould bartered bargained & made sall of, fiftie Ackers of land, that I th^e afforesd Erickson bought of W^m Leedes, & th^e same Cleme title & intrest th^t I th^e sd Ericson had, Assigned ouere unto mee by W^m Leedes, I doth acknowledge by these p^rsents to haue sould th^e same unto Joseph weickes, Inioyninge mee my heires Executo^{rs} or Assignes, to Confirme & make good th^e salle theareof, unto th^e afforesd Weickes, his heires Executo^{rs} or Assigns foreuer, in th^e same maner & forme as was Assigned & made ouer to mee th^e sayd Erickson from th^e afforesd Leedes, I doe by these p^rsents Assigne & Confirme the same sall unto th^e afforesd Weickes his heires Executo^{rs} or Assignes, From mee th^e aforesd Erickson my heires Executo^{rs} or Assignes foreuer, And further I th^e sd Erickson doth acknowledge, to haue Receiued of th^e afforesd Weecks full satisfaction for any Cleme or debt due to mee, th^e sd Erickson by Condition or Order of Cou^{rt} theareupon, from th^e Estate of Edward Tarrent dessassed & to th^e true p^rformance heareof, I bind mee my heires Executo^{rs} or Assignes well and trully to p^rforme as wittnes my hand this 30th of March 1656

The Cou^{rt} hauinge Re^c information upon Oath that Edward Rogers is guiltie of th^e breach of an Act of Assembly; the sd Rogers also Confessinge in Cou^{rt} th^t hee shott & kild a turkey upon a sunday Contrarie to the sd Act; pleadinge For himselfe th^t this was was his first offence, of th^t nature, & th^t hee was Ignorant of th^e Act of Assembly p^rhibittinge shootinge on sundayes; & Is sorie for his Offence, p^rmissing neuer to doe the lick

The Cou^{rt} is pleased For this time, to accept his plea, & to Impose noe Further penaltie upon him, saue only, th^e sd Rogers shall pay the Charges of th^e suite, els Execution
