To All people to whome this present writing shall Come I Phillip Barre of Manonoakin in th^e province of Maryland plantor send greeting Knowe yee th^t I th^e said Phillip Barre for th^e Loue good will & affection w^{ch} I haue & beare towards my loving wife Oliue Barre of Manonoakin in th^e province aforesaid spinster haue given & granted & by these presents freely Clearly & absolutely giue & grante unto th^e said Oliue Barre her heires execut^{rs} adm^{rs} or assignes one ewe being marked one th^e right ear cropt & slitt one th^e left with all her & their Increase; To haue & to hould the said Ewe with all her & their Increase unto th^e said Oliue Barre heires execut^{rs} adm^{rs} or assignes from henceforth to her & their owne p^{per} use & as her & their owne p^{per} goods for ever absolutely without any manner of Condi^{on}s & soe forth & I th^e said Phillip Barre haue sett & putt my beloved wife Oliue Barre in quiett possession of th^e p^{rmises} in wittnes whereof I huae hereunto sett my hand & seale this eleventh of december one thousand six hundred sixty & fiue
