After Some Debate the pl^t made appeare before the board that he had Served the full time of his Servitude Whereupon th^e Courte orders that th^e Said Henry Boston shall pay the Said Tho: Moolson his Corne & Clothes according to Act of Assembly in such Cases provided with Cost of Sute otherwise execu^on
