In a difference dependinge betweene Richard Ambrose Pl^t & John Kimborrow Defd^t the Pl^t declares by Nicholas Best his Attornⁿ & the Defd^t appeares to defend the suite Vizt the Pl^t saith that the Defd^t Did on 20th of May in th^e 41th yeare of the Dominion of Caecilius &c receive of him the Pl^t goods & m̄chandizes to the value of Seaven hundred twenty & fower pounds of tobacco which the Defd^t did assume & promise to pay to the Pl^t neglectinge & refuseinge the Pl^t saith he is damnified two thousand pounds of tob^o in regard he is bound away for England by the first Convayance, the Pl^t proveinge his declaracōn obteyned Judgm^t for Seaven hundred twenty fower pounds of tobacco & Costs of Suite which followes on the oth^r side
