No. 9 An Act for the Adjournment and Continuance of Frederick County Court

Whereas an Adjournment of Frederick County Court is at this time necessary many of the members of the lower house being absent through sickness and several of the members whose Attendance on their duty here cannot be dispensed with having also necessary Business in the said Court [Preamble]

Be it therefore Enacted by the right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and with the Advice and consent of his Lordships Governor and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly and the Authority of the same That all Causes Pleas Process and proceedings either Civil or Criminal now depending in or returnable to the said County Court to be held the third Tuesday of November in this present year shall be and are by Virtue of this Act adjourned and continued from the said third Tuesday in November until the first Tuesday in December next and shall be in the same Pliht and Condition as they would be on the said third Tuesday of November any Law usage or Custom to the Contrary notwithstanding p. 62r [Frederick County Court Adjourn'd]
