The Baltimore Petitions relative to the Removal of the Court House  
May Session 1768

[PETITIONS [38]-[41]] WERE APPARENTLY THE LAST FOUR PETITIONS FOR REMOVAL WHICH WERE HANDED IN BY THE SOLICITORS FOR SIGNATURES. THEY BEGIN A NEW ENUMERATION AND ARE NUMBERED 1 TO 4 IN A CONTEMPORARY HAND; THEY ALSO BEAR HIGHER CONTEMPORARY TABULATION FIGURES. PETITION 1 [38] IS THE ENGLISH-GERMAN BROADSIDE FORM. PETITIONS 2 [39]-4 [41] ARE THE VARIANT ENGLISH BROADSIDE FORM (WROTH NO. 285); THIS WAS DOUBTLESS A LATER ISSUE FROM THE HASSELBACH PRESS THAN THE MORE NUMEROUS ENGLISH BROADSIDE FORM (WROTH NO. 286), AND WERE ISSUED WHEN ADDITIONAL PETITION FORMS WERE REQUIRED.
