And whereupon the said Kenelm in his pp pson saith that whereas the said Cornelius the Second day of October in the yeare 1671 by his certeine writing obligatory sealed w<sup>th</sup> the Seale of the said Cornelius and here in Co<sup>rt</sup> pduced, whose date is the day and yeare abovewritten did acknowledge himself to owe and stand indebted unto the said Kenelm the su<sup>m</sup>e of fifteene hundred pounds of good Marchantable Tobacco and Casque to be payd to the said Kenelm his heires Executo<sup>rs</sup> Adm<sup>rs</sup> or Assignes upon Demaund and to the paym<sup>t</sup> of the same did binde himself his heires Executo<sup>rs</sup> and Adm<sup>rs</sup> firmly by these p<sup>r</sup>sents Notwithstanding w<sup>ch</sup> the said Cornelius the said su<sup>m</sup>e of fifteene hundred pounds of Tobacco according to the Tenor of his said bill hath not payd though often Required but the same to pay Denyes to the Damage of the said Kenelm Two thowsand pounds of Tobacco and thereupon he brings his suite.

And the said Cornelius by George Parker his Attorney cometh & Defendeth the force and injury when &c and prayeth liberty of Speaking thereunto untill the first day of the next Provincial Co<sup>rt</sup> and the same day is given to both ptyes.

At w<sup>ch</sup>day that is to say the 12<sup>th</sup> day of Novemb<sup>r</sup> in the 42<sup>th</sup> yeare of y<sup>e</sup> Dominion of Caecilius &c Annoq<sup>ue</sup> Domini 1673. came the said Kenelm Chiseldyne in his pp pson and offered himself ag<sup>t</sup> the said Cornelius of and upon the p<sup>r</sup>mises and the said Cornelius appeared not but made Default wherefore it is considered by the Co<sup>rt</sup> here that the said Kenelm Recover ag<sup>t</sup> the said Cornelius Stewart aswell the said su<sup>m</sup>e of fifteene hundred pounds of Tobacco his Debt afore-sayd as also the su<sup>m</sup>e of \_\_\_\_\_ pounds of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges in this behalfe Expended and the said Cornelius in mercy &c.
