

Walter Storey and Michael Martin, Executors of Anne Lynes, Executrix of Philip Lynes v. His Majesty. Upon a bond given under the Navigation Act, 12 Charles II, ch. 18.

Arthur Miller, Executor of Michael Miller v. Her Majesty. Upon bond given under the Navigation Act, 12 Charles II, ch. 18.

Grace Mitchell and Daniel Philips, Administrators of Henry Mitchell v. Her Majesty. Upon bond given under the Navigation Act, 12 Charles II, ch. 18.

Renatus Smith and Anthony Ivey, Executors of Robert Smith v. Thomas Robins. Upon bond to indemnify against loss on another bond. Record interrupted before conclusion of this proceeding.

Richard Bennett v. James and Peregrine Frisby, Administrators of Thomas Frisby. By creditor of deceased on administration bond. There was an appeal noted to the King in Council, but it was apparently not prosecuted.

*His Lordship v. Thomas Cockshutt.*¹ By creditor of decedent on administration bond.

His Lordship v. Thomas Lingan, Executor of Edward Boteler. Upon an executor's bond.

Walter Storey and Michael Martin, Executors of Ann Lynes, Executrix of Philip Lynes v. Her Majesty. Upon bond given under the Navigation Act, 12 Charles II, ch. 18.

His Majesty v. Daniel Jenifer and Elizabeth his wife. Upon bond of a sheriff for fees collected.

His Majesty v. William Stone. Against another surety on the same bond as that sued on in the previous case.

His Majesty (sometimes The King) v. Henry Ennalls. Upon an executor's bond for failure to account.

Michael Macnemara, son and heir of Thomas Macnemara v. Thomas Brooke. Upon a bond of indemnity to a garnishee paying in an attachment suit.

Francis Skirven v. Richard Willis. Against a coroner for judgment debt lost by escape of a debtor taken in execution.²

Proprietary v. Roger Mathews. Against a surety on the bond of a sheriff for not paying over amounts collected for the commissary general. The record concludes without complete transcription of this case.
