 And whereupon he said Thomas Manlove for himself saith  
 that in the 22<sup>nd</sup> year of the Dominion of the Rt Hon<sup>ble</sup>  
 Cecilius or Anno<sup>y</sup> Domini one thousand six hundred sixty  
 eight he the said Robert Catterin did assume and promise  
 to pay or cause to be paid at the fall next ensuing to the said  
 Thomas Manlove four Dutch Dots of silver being for a  
 valuable consideration in hand paid But he the said  
 Robert Catterin hath regarding his promise and assumption  
 made to him the said Thomas doth deny and still doth to pay  
 the said four Dutch Dots although often demanded by p<sup>l</sup>t  
 saith he is damaged and hath damage to be valued at  
 four hundred pounds of tobacco and thereupon  
 brings his bill or i/i

The d<sup>l</sup>t doct<sup>r</sup> desired that he may prove that he  
 is four Dutch Dots due to him at  
 The p<sup>l</sup>t doct<sup>r</sup> desired directions having answered but  
 not in p<sup>l</sup>t ord<sup>r</sup> for directions till next p<sup>l</sup>t  
 The p<sup>l</sup>t doct<sup>r</sup> withdrew from action the same day  
 after 6 p<sup>l</sup>t was risen
