 administrators or assigns to enter three hundred acres of Land in
 the name of Daniell Moore and for the use of the said Daniell into
 his Sopp^r Secretaries office and for the true performance of the same
 I do binde my selfe my heirs executors in the penalty of five hundred
 pounds of Tobacco for the true performance of the same as witness my
 hand and seal this 10th of January 1670
