 Leeb for the full term of three year wanting only one month or two with warranty from all
 person or persons whosoever as witness my hand this 20th February A^o 1673: Isaac Jacob

on the back side of the said writing written vizt I James Treasterle doe assigne over all my
 right & title of this assignment unto Cornelius Johnson or his assigne 16th May 1673: James Treasterle

This C^o taking the premises into their serious Consideration doe order by the p^l John Leeb
 doe serve his master Cornelius Johnson or his assigne According to y^e assignment here produced in
 C^o: And if in case the said John Leeb make appeare otherwise then the said Cornelius Johnson
 to pay him a years service

This C^o orderd y^e execution shall issue ag^t: Stephen Cannon alias Thomas Davis to satisfie James
 Jonestons & Lany Jonestons his wife the execution of James Weddon deceased four hundred and
 thirty pounds of tobacco & Cost

 quantity of one thousand & fifty seven pounds of tobacco as p^l his an^o: here in C^o produced more
 plainly doth & may appeare but y^e said Edward fraudulently intending to deceive him the said
 William of the above^d 1015 of tobacco demijon & full doz deny to pay the same though often he was
 required whereby the plaintiffe saith he is damaged & hath lost to y^e value of 2030 of tobacco and
