

Richard Lewis: This examination saith upon his oath that William Broadwell in Decemr last past bought along boate of Cornelius Johnson of Lorumole in y<sup>e</sup> County of Sommersett planto: And the said Cornelius was to rigg & sell the same long boate & make her fit to sayle by the 12<sup>th</sup> of Jan<sup>y</sup>: then next following Richard Lewis  
The former proceedings in this Co<sup>rt</sup> being read in his cause depending betweene William Broadwell p<sup>te</sup> ag<sup>t</sup> Cornelius Johnson of Lorumole def<sup>t</sup>: This Co<sup>rt</sup> orders that the def<sup>t</sup> Cornelius Johnson pay unto the p<sup>te</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Broadwell or his order six hundred pounds of tobacco with cost of his alial expences

Sommersett s<sup>r</sup>: Alexander Younger of this County gent<sup>l</sup> declares ag<sup>t</sup> Edward Smith gent<sup>l</sup> one of his H<sup>on</sup>rs Justices for this County in an action of detinue

And whereupon the said Alex<sup>r</sup> by his attorney Edward Jones saith that the said Edward Smith hath detained from the said Younger one Trunk with severall goods in it & bills vizt one Chamber (boate) one peece of worsted perrilla one peece of perpetuana one peece of fine Linnen 10<sup>th</sup> divers other goods w<sup>th</sup> Trunk & goods as aboves<sup>d</sup> the aforesaid Younger brought in by him of the aforesaid Smith about the 14<sup>th</sup> day of March last past with y<sup>e</sup> Consent of the aforesaid Smith but the aforesaid Smith fraudulently detaining the aforesaid Trunk & goods from y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Younger whereupon the aforesaid Younger saith he is dammified & hath dammifyed to y<sup>e</sup> value of 2990<sup>l</sup> of tobacco whereupon brings his Sub<sup>a</sup>: p<sup>er</sup> quer Edw<sup>d</sup> Jones

Henry Bishop appears in this cause depending & maketh oath but not taken in writing  
This Co<sup>rt</sup> orders that the def<sup>t</sup> Edward Smith deliver y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>te</sup> Alexander Younger the Trunk & goods in his Custody

And whereupon the said Alexander by his attorney Edward Jones saith the said Edward became indebted unto the aforesaid Alex<sup>r</sup> in the summe of two thousand four hundred & some few pounds of tobacco as doth appear by account w<sup>th</sup> account rec<sup>d</sup> have to produce in Co<sup>rt</sup>: but the aforesaid Edward his promise & assumption little regarding but fraudulently intending him to deceive in the summe of 2414<sup>l</sup> of tobacco And the aforesaid Edward refuseth to pay & still doth refuse to pay the aforesaid summe of 2414<sup>l</sup> of tobacco whereupon the aforesaid Alexander saith he is dammified and hath dammage to the value of two thousand nine hundred ninety nine pounds of tobacco whereupon he bringeth his Sub<sup>a</sup>:
