Injunct^o as followeth

- Edward Price of this County for the entertaining of John Kemp & Florence Innom Serv^{ts} to Capt^o John Bunder from Monday the 12th of May 1673 till Sunday following
 - Jane Servant to John Copper for bearing a bastard Child about June last
 - Chorocho an Indian belonging to the King of Copomo for hogstealing discovered about the last of May 1673
 - Matka an Indian commonly called Ditt belonging to y^e King of Condolan for hogstealing
 - Peter Whaples & Henry Phillipps for falsely reporting that Tho. Shants wife was delivered of a child or murthered
 - Mathew Baker Servant to John Postman for bearing a bastard Child about the first of August 1673
 - Margarett Hall Serv^t to Thomas Hobbs for bearing a bastard Child about the first of May 1673
 - Elizabeth Williams Serv^t to Jacob Blaring for bearing two bastard Children about the first of April 1673
 - Christopher Muter & W^m Shunare being summoned to be of y^e Grand Jury & not appearing
 - Anne vint for coming with William vint pretending he was her husband but afterwards discovered they lived together as man & wife now he said Anne living at W^m Arnes leading an Idle life
 - Thomas Jones: Charles Cunniff at y^e same house: Robert Devie at the same house: Emannell Col^o Colebourne
 - Negro: Joseph Night his serv^t W^m Lewis living at the same house: John Roth Jun^r: John Roth Jun^r W^m Gromer
