Senate bill entitled "An Act to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Prince George's county to construct a public county road upon and along the Washington Turnpike Road between Laurel and line of District of Columbia, to borrow money on the credit of said county for the construction of said road and issue coupon bonds therefor, and to levy and collect on and from the assessable property of said county an annual tax sufficient to pay said bonds when they mature and the interest thereon as it becomes due."

2. In line 2 of section 1, strike out the words "as directed," and insert as follows: "In their discretion."
