AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

By Mr. Putzel:

Amend by striking out from the word “each,” in line 2 of section 2, to the word “and” on line 4 of said section 2; to be added to section 2, charter of the Mercantile Bank of Baltimore.:

“And said stockholders shall be liable to the amount of their respective shares of said stock for all debts and liabilities of said corporation upon note, bill or otherwise.”
