Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to add an additional section to Article 13, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title 'Bills of Exchange and Promissory Notes,' to come in after section 11, and to be known as 'Section 11 A.'"

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to change the name of the Potomac and Severn Electric Railway Company, and to grant certain additional powers and privileges to said corporation, and to confirm franchises and privileges granted to said corporation by the Mayor, Counsellor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis."

Leave was granted to the Committee on Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled "An Act to sanction the bequest of certain moneys arising out of the sale of certain lands to the convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church of Diocese of Easton, in trust for the keeping up of the property belonging to All Saints Parish in said Diocese, by the last will and testament of George R. Goldsborough, of Talbot county."
